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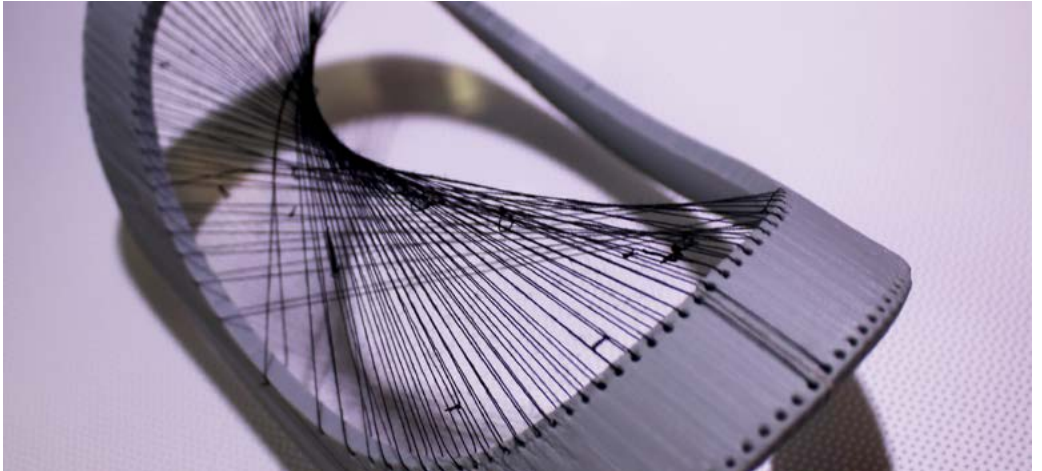
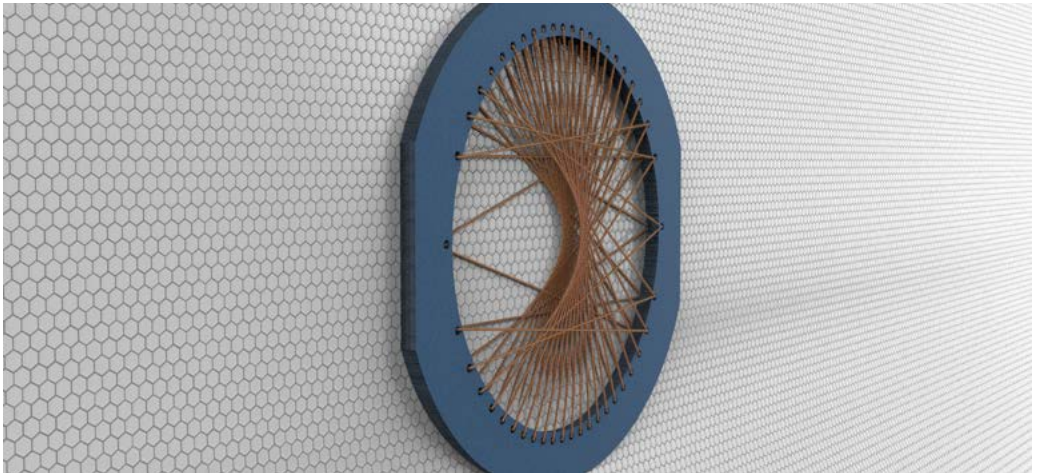
The Cradle Chair

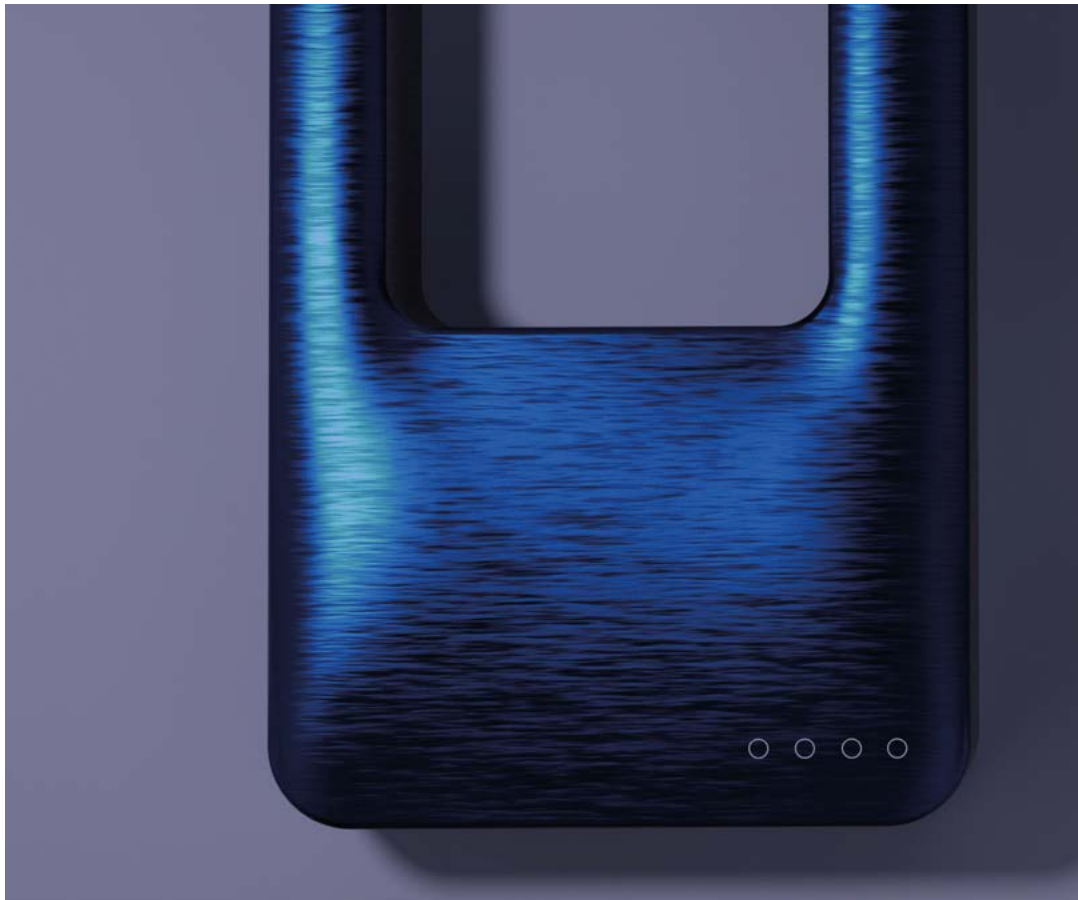
“Reducing waste to increase availability”

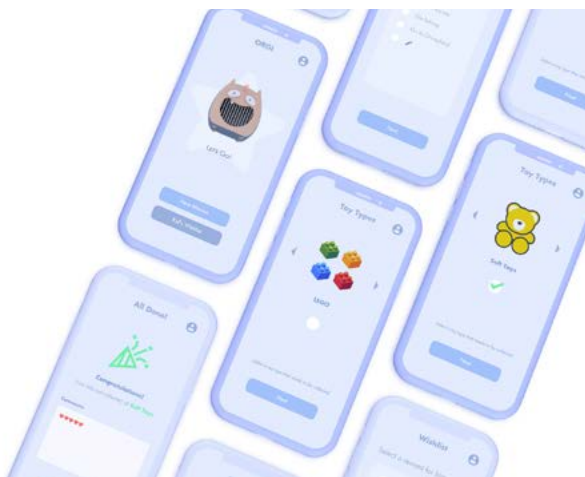
“It’s time to feed your little monster!”
