

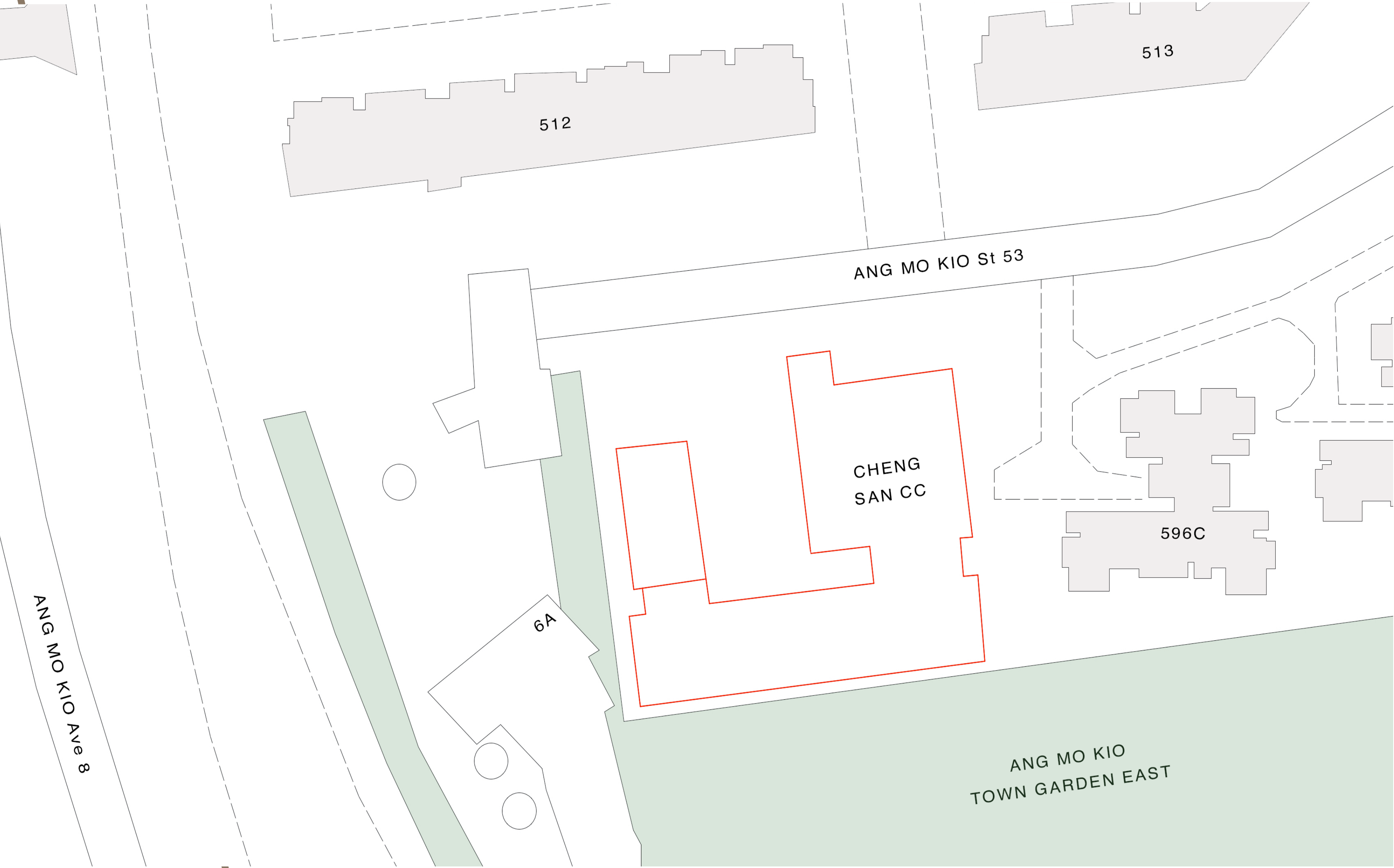

Ang Mo Kio Street 53, Singapore



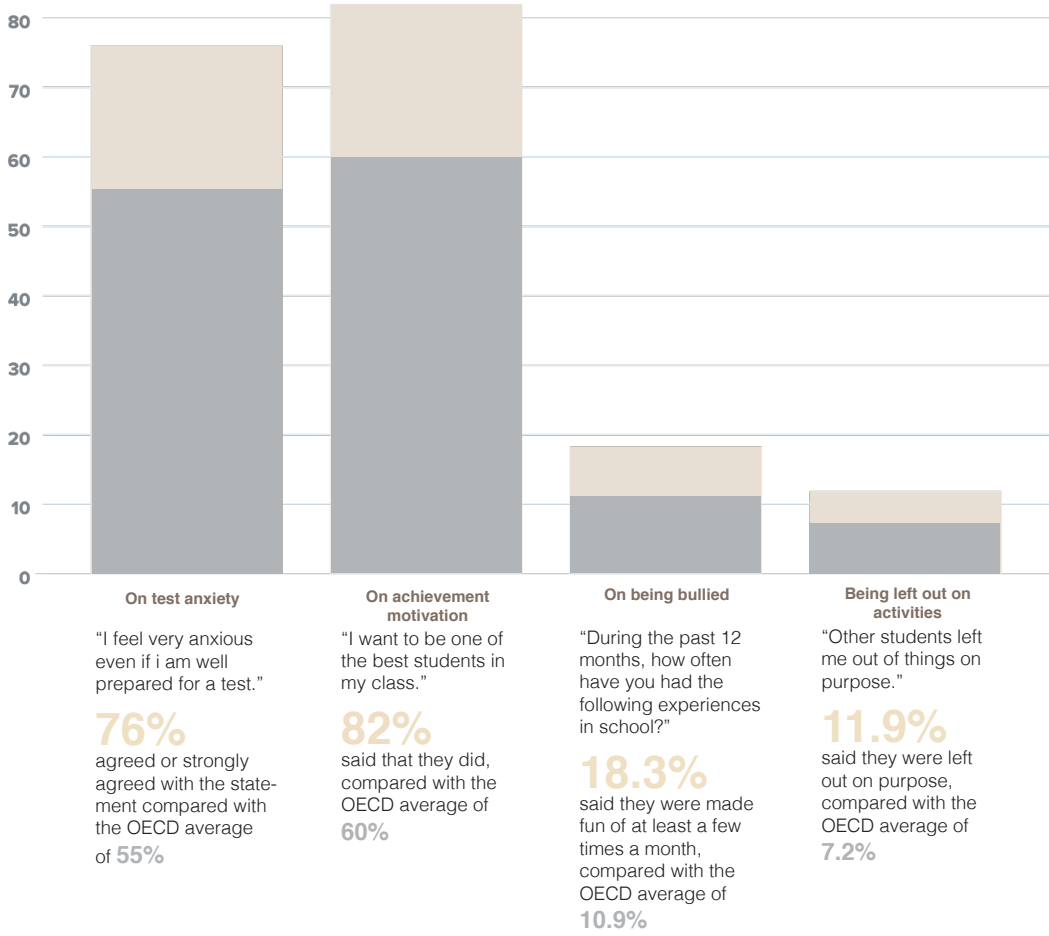
FACTS

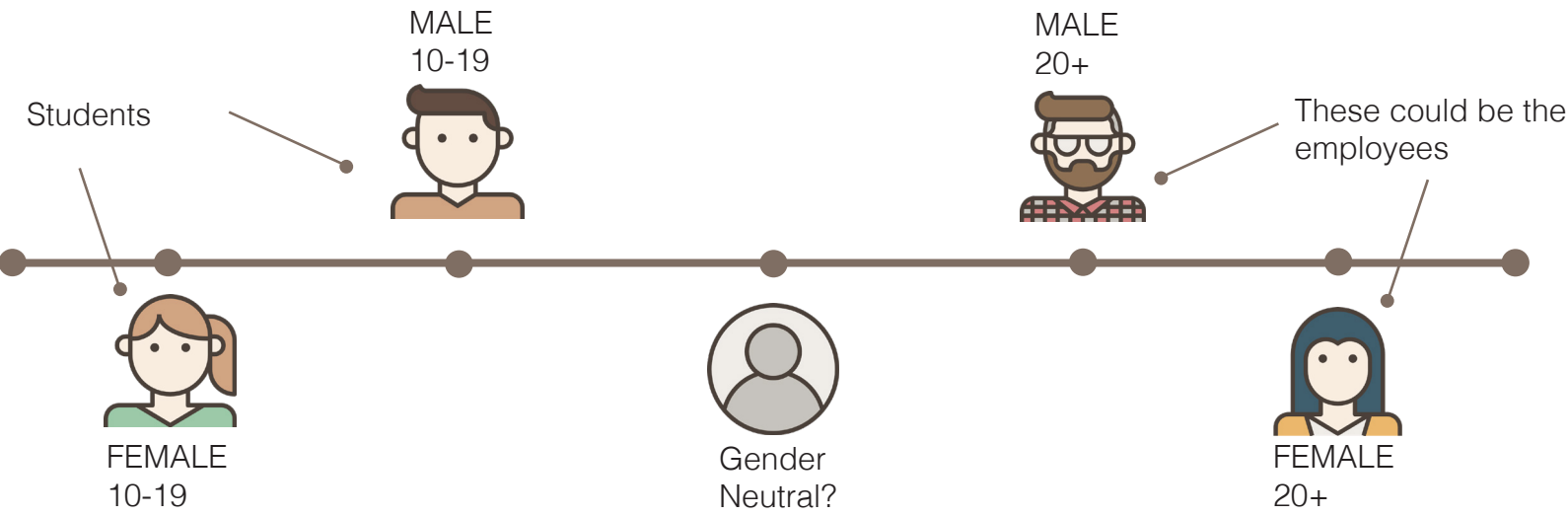
Creating a space that embraces minimal natural light can get despairing, especially in individuals who may have conditions such as 'Seasonal Affective Disorder' (SAD).

Students who are looking for a place to study peacefully and safely.

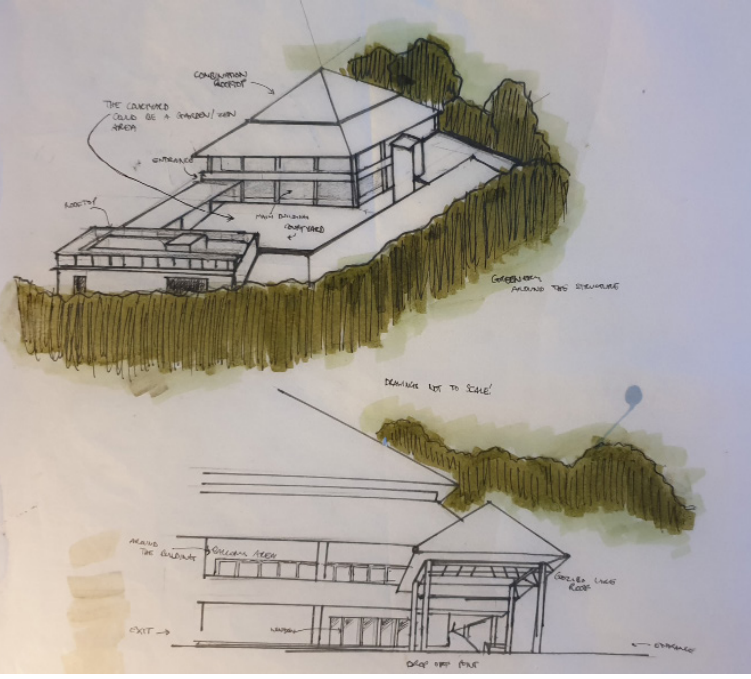
