GAME LAB is a game design studio based in Taiwan specialising in boardgame designs. They emphasize in creating games that encourages the diversity interactions among its players, creating thematic storylines and physical items to trigger people to gather and play especially for the family.

GAME LAB consists of 8 people in their studio which includes creative director, salesperson, two storytelling members and four game design members. Normally, they work together in the office designing the game and the package. Like any other boardgames design studio, games are tested and are sent to be produced in the factory and to be promoted to the public





Quality of lifestyle determines our perspective of thinking. The living qualities of the millennials in Hong Kong is degrading each year by year; living in a cramp space with their parents; unable to afford a decent space with affordable price. 76% of adults' age ranged from 18-35 in Hong Kong still lived with their parents and are struggling financially to own their own space (City Urban Research Group, 2014). Rising housing prices and limited spaces have enforced a peer group of Hong Kong university graduates into living in a small space as small as 5 square metres, such little space even when they work up to five jobs to pay the bills.

Weave is a versatile space, a place which objective is to serve as both coliving space and co-working space. It is designed for young millenials who are striving hard in current society.








Oasis
